Three ways to get involved:

Tier 1: Champions of the Seven Cs – Celebration Assembly

- Schools nominate up to 10 students for their character and effort.
- Winners receive medals, certificates, and a celebration assembly (in-person or virtual). Celebration hosted by Baasit Siddiqui

Tier 2: Passports to Thrive – Year-Round Recognition

- Students track achievements in Passports to Thrive booklets.
- Schools use these to select award winners.

Tier 3: Let's Thrive Digital Workshops – Real-World Learning

- Engaging digital workshops in entrepreneurship, media, and public speaking.
- Students develop projects linked to the Seven Cs.

The Seven C's to Thrive

Le'ts Thrive helps develop, articulate and celebrate the Seven C's to Thrive. These are:

Creativity – Finding innovative ways to solve problems. **Collaboratio**n – Working together to achieve great things **Compromise** – Respecting different views and reaching agreements.

Communication – Sharing ideas effectively.

Curiosity – Always questioning, learning, and growing. .**Community** – Supporting and contributing to those around us.

Courage – Taking risks and embracing failure



How to Bring Let's Thrive to your Education Setting

Baasit recognises the incredible work being done by teachers and education professionals in often challenging circumstances.

Let's Thrive has been created to work flexibly within your setting to celebrate young people and the wider school community. It can be done through different tiers of support depending on budget and time.



Tier 1: Champions of Seven C's Celebratory Assembly



Recognising and Rewarding Student Excellence

- 1.School/College/MAT identify up to 10 outstanding students who exemplify the Seven Cs.
- 2. Teachers, form tutors, or even parents complete a simple "**Evidence of Excellence**" application to nominate students.
- 3. Baasit visits the students (or delivers a virtual assembly) to host a high-energy **awards ceremony**, recognising the winners with medals, certificates, and a professional photo opportunity.
- 4. If a **company sponsors** the event, the setting will receive a "Let's Thrive School" plaque celebrating the partnership.

This tier is ideal for education settings that want a simple yet impactful way to celebrate their students and the education setting.

Tier 2: Passports to Thrive



A Year-Round Recognition System

- 1. In addition to the Celebration Assembly, students receive **Passports to Thrive**—small booklets where they log their achievements in each of the Seven Cs.
- 2. Primary, secondary, and college versions ensure ageappropriate engagement.
- 3. Teachers can use these passports to track progress, encourage reflection, and **strengthen student nominations** for the Celebration Assembly.

This tier helps students take ownership of their growth, reinforcing positive behaviours throughout the year.

Tier 3: Let's Thrive Digital Projects



Bringing Learning to Life

- 1. Schools gain access to Let's Thrive Digital Projects, which empower students to develop **real-world skills** linked to the Seven Cs.
- 2. The Projects Develop Skills In:
 - a. Entrepreneurship & Innovation
 - b. Digital Literacy & Storytelling
 - c. Presentation & Public Speaking
- 3. Students use the Passports to Thrive to reflect on their progress, and their work can be **showcased** in Celebration Assembly.

This tier is perfect for secondary schools and colleges looking to integrate innovative learning experiences into their character education programs.
